The Devils defeated the Oilers, 5-2, in regulation in their first contest of the 2018-19 campaign. New Jersey improved to 3-1-1 at home against Edmonton since the 2013-14 regular season. In season openers, New Jersey has a 20-10-6 record overall and 17-15-4 at home. The club has won it's past two season openers. New Jersey had two multi-goal scorers against Edmonton in their season opener (**Kyle Palmieri**-2G, and **Travis Zajac**-2G) for only the second time in franchise history (including KC and COL). **Sergei Brylin** and **Brian Gionta** each scored 2 when Devils beat Penguins in the 2005-06 opener. (*credit Elias Sports Bureau*).

Miles Wood notched two assists on the night (marking the first time in his career that he has tallied a point on opening night). Will Butcher, Nico Hischier, Mirco Mueller, Damon Severson, and Sami Vatanen all chipped in with one assist, while Stefan Noesen added an empty net goal.

New Jersey will face-off against Edmonton one more time this regular season, March 13 at Rogers Place.

TONIGHT'S GAME vs. WASHINGTON CAPITALS

Tonight is the first of four regular-season contests between New Jersey and Washington in 2018-19. In 2017-18, New Jersey was 1-3-0 against Washington in the regular season series.

Sami Vatanen led the charge in 2017-18 notching four points (4A) in the regular season series. Brian Boyle lead the club with 17 PIM over four games, while Taylor Hall, and Miles Wood led the squad with two goals a piece.

Nicklas Backstrom led the Capitals with nine points in the regular-season series matchup (3G-6A).

The Devils are 3-6-1 at Prudential Center and are 4-12-3 overall against the Caps since the 2013-14 season.

Tonight's matchup is New Jersey's second of a five-game, home-stand (1-0-0). The Devils and Capitals will meet again on November 30, at Capital One Arena.

HISTORY

SEASON OPENING RECORDS

In season openers, New Jersey has a 20-10-6 record overall and 17-15-4 in home openers.

*The NHL record for assists in a season opener is five, set by Devils forward Greg Adams on October 10, 1985 against the Flyers and later matched by Pittsburgh forward John Cullen on October 5, 1990.

INJURIES

Cory Schneider (Hip Surgery) is rehabbing and skating with team.

Jesper Bratt (Fractured Jaw, suffered Oct. 4) is on I.R.

HALL'S GOT HART

On June 20, Taylor Hall was awarded the Hart Memorial Trophy, which is awarded annually to the "player judged most valuable to his team" in the National Hockey League. Hall is the first Devil to win the prestigious award.

In 2017-18, Hall set new career highs in goals (39), assists (54) and points (93) through 75 games played this season. In the 2018 calendar year, Hall recorded points in 36 of 39 games played, registering 57PTS (27G-30A).

Hall was also the first Devils player to reach the 90-point mark (39G-54A-93PTS) in a season since Zach Parise (45G-49A-94PTS) in 2008-09.

Additionally, Hall (93) posted a 41-point lead over Nico Hischier (52), which is the largest margin between the top two point producers on the Devils since the 2008-09 season (Z. Parise, 94 - P. Elias, 78 = 16 PT difference).

To add to the MVP's incredible season, the Calgary, Alb. native recorded the longest point streak in the NHL last season and set the Devils franchise record (P. Elias, 1999-00; B. Gionta, 2005-06; 15 each). He registered at least one point in 26 straight appearances (18G-20A-38PTS) dating back to Jan. 2 at STL.

During that 26-game span, he missed three games, Jan. 22-25, due to an injury (right hand/thumb).

Halls' consecutive point-streak was snapped at 19 games on Mar. 8 vs. the Winnipeg Jets (Jan. 30-Mar. 6, 13G-13A-26PTS).

MASTERTON TROPHY WINNER

On that same night, Brian Boyle was awarded the Bill Masterton Trophy which is given annually to the National Hockey League player who best exemplifies the qualities of perseverance, sportsmanship, and dedication to ice hockey. Boyle is the second Devil to win the admirable award.

Boyle was diagnosed with Chronic Myelogenous Lukemia (CML), a form of bone marrow cancer, at the beginning of last years training camp. Boyle started treatment immediately, and returned to the team to face-off against the Edmonton Oilers on November 3.

NEW FACES BEHIND THE BENCH

The Devils brought in two new assistant coaches this past off-season after Geoff Ward (Associate Coach, CGY), and Ryan Clowe (Head Coach, Newfoundland - ECHL) left the team after the ECQF loss to TB.

Rick Kowalsky completed his eighth season as head coach of the AHL Devils (Albany, Binghamton) at the end of the 2017-18 season. He led the franchise to back-to-back playoff berths in 2015-16 and 2016-17. In 2015-16, the club had its most successful season to date, with 46 wins and 102 points, earning him the AHL Coach of the Year Award. Over his AHL coaching career, he has a record of 281 wins, 249 losses and 82 overtime/shootout losses in 612 games.

Mike Grier played 1,060 NHL games as a right wing over 14 seasons with Edmonton (1996-97 to 2001-02), Washington (2002-03 to 2003-04), Buffalo (2003-04 to 2005-06 & 2009-10 to 2010-11) and San Jose (2006-07 to 2008-09). He set career highs across the board in 1998-99 with Edmonton when he scored 20 goals, 24 assists and 44 points. In 101 Stanley Cup Playoff games, Grier tallied 14 goals and 14 assists for 28 points and 72 penalty minutes. He made the playoffs in 11 of his 14 seasons in the League. Grier officially retired on December 1, 2011. The 6-1, 225lb. forward played three seasons of collegiate hockey at Boston University, where he was teammates with Hynes.

For the past four seasons, Grier served as a Pro Scout with the Chicago Blackhawks. He also served as an assistant coach for St. Sebastian's High School in Needham, MA, where he played his scholastic hockey, and coached the Boston Junior Terriers.

Mark Dennehy will replace Kowalsky behind the bench for Binghamton. Dennehy coached for 13 seasons at Merrimack, posting 161 wins, and helped turn the program around. In 2010-11, he led the team to the most successful season in school history with a record 25 wins, as the Warriors advanced to the Hockey East Final and NCAA Regionals. For his efforts, Dennehy won the Bob Kullen Coach of the Year Award as the conference's top coach. For the past four seasons, he coached Devils' draft pick Brett Seney who signed in March.

Ryan Parent will join Dennehy as an assist. Parent was a first-round draft pick of the Nashville Predators, 18th overall, in 2005. He played in 106 NHL games with Vancouver and Philadelphia, notching one goal and six assists. He also played in 27 career Stanley Cup Playoff games. The left-shooting defenseman played in 251 AHL games with seven teams between 2006 and 2016, where he registered four goals and 24 assists with 261 penalty minutes.

DEVILS GO ABROAD

The Devils-Oilers matchup on Oct. 6 was the 23rd NHL regular-season game played in Europe, the 11th such game played in Sweden, and the first NHL regular-season game played in Gothenburg as part of the NHL Global Series.

The Devils traveled to Bern, Switzerland, and played an exhibition game against SC Bern on Monday, Oct. 1 (3-2 Wo) at PostFinance Arena.

TONIGHT'S GAME

The Capitals face the New Jersey Devils on Thursday in the first of four meetings between the teams this season. Washington holds a 108-74-13-15 record against New Jersey all-time and a 9-0-2 record in the last 11 games.

NOTE OF THE NIGHT

Climbing the Ranks - With two goals against the Vegas Golden Knights, Alex Ovechkin passed Bobby Hull (610) for 17th place on the NHL's all-time goals list. Coincidentally, when Ovechkin captured his seventh career Maurice "Rocket" Richard Trophy in 2017-18, he joined Hull (also 7x, all w/ CHI) as the only players in NHL history to finish atop the League's goal-scoring race seven times. In addition, Ovechkin recorded his first multi-goal game of the 2018-19 season and the 121st such outing of his NHL career, tops among active players. He moved into a tie with Hull and Jari Kurri for the 14th-most multi-goal games in NHL history. Ovechkin now sits 15 goals shy of passing Joe Sakic and Jarome Iginla (625) for 15th place on the all-time goals list. Ovechkin, the NHL's active leader in goals (611)

as well as the Capitals franchise leader, is the only player in NHL history to win a Calder Memorial Trophy, an Art Ross Trophy, a Hart Memorial Trophy, a Ted Lindsay Award, a Maurice "Rocket" Richard Trophy and a Conn Smythe Trophy. Last season Ovechkin became the 20th player in history - and fourth fastest - to reach 600 goals. Ovechkin leads the NHL in power play goals (230) and shots (4,911) since 1994-95, despite making his NHL debut in 2005-06. In the last six seasons, he has 64 more goals than the next closest skater. He's the first player in NHL history to lead the league in power-play goals for four straight seasons. In 2017-18 he led the NHL in goals for the seventh time, finishing with 49, and he's tied with Hull for the most times a single player has led the NHL in goals.

TOP FIVE CAPS FACTS

Hot Start – Washington has scored 18 goals in three games to open the 2018-19 campaign, establishing a new franchise record for most through the first three games of a season (previously 17 in 1988-89). The Capitals' six goals per game leads the NHL.

Kuz Control – Evgeny Kuznetsov's seven points (3g, 4a) leads the Capitals this season and is tied for the sixth most in the NHL. In his last 54 games, including the regular season and playoffs, Kuznetsov has recorded 73 points (28g, 45a). Over a full 82-game regular season, that equates to 111 points. During that span, Kuznetsov has recorded 20 multi-point efforts, including four four-point games. Kuznetsov has 272 points (83g, 189a) in 343 career games, and his 0.79 points per game ranks fifth among all players selected in the 2010 NHL Draft. Additionally, Kuznetsov's 0.55 assists per game leads all forwards selected in the 2010 NHL Draft.

All That Power - Through the first three games of the season, the Capitals are 6 for 12 on the power play, and their six power play goals leads the NHL. Last season, Washington ranked seventh in power play percentage (22.5 percent). John Carlson led the team with 32 power play points (4g, 28a), which ranked second among all defensemen. The Capitals held a 29-7-3 record when they scored at least one power play goal last season. Since the 2009-10 season, the Capitals' 22.5 cumulative power play percentage (511 goals on 2,267 opportunities) ranks first, two percentage points higher than the Pittsburgh Penguins, who rank second. Ovechkin's 230 career power play goals rank first among active players, 65 more goals than Patrick Marleau in 573 fewer games, who ranks second among active players. Additionally, Backstrom's 269 career power play assists ranks third among active players.

Bedeviling New Jersey - The Capitals have earned a point in 11 consecutive games against the Devils (9-0-2) and have scored five or more goals in five of their last seven games.. Braden Holtby has posted a 15-3-3 record in his career against the Devils with four shutouts, tied for the most shutouts he has against a single opponent, a 1.98 goals-against average and a .925 save percentage. Holtby's 15 wins are tied for his most against a team (Boston Bruins). Alex Ovechkin has earned 54 points (24g, 30a) in 49 career games against New Jersey and has tallied 15 points in his last 12 games against the Devils (7g, 8a). John Carlson's 21 points (4g, 17a) in 31 games is tied for the most points he has against a single franchise (Carolina Hurricanes: 5g, 16a in 38 games).

Protective Cops – Caps goaltender Phoenix Copley is expected to start against the New Jersey Devils. Copley, 26, posted a record of 15-17-6 record with two shutouts, a 2.91 goals-against average and a .896 save percentage in 41 games with Hershey last season. Copley also posted a 26-11-3 record with one shutout, a 2.25 goals-against average and a .924 save percentage in 41 AHL games with the Chicago Wolves and Hershey Bears in 2016-17. The North Pole, Alaska, native ranked seventh in the AHL in goals-against average, tied for seventh in wins and tied for eighth in save percentage. In 142 career AHL games with Hershey and Chicago, Copley posted a 72-47-15 record with nine shutouts, a 2.53 goals-against average and a .914 save percentage. Copley appeared in two career NHL games with the St. Louis Blues. Copley made his NHL debut on Feb. 27, 2016, at Nashville and made 24 saves in his first career NHL start on Jan. 21, 2017 at Winnipeg.

Additional Capitals Notes

A Decade of Greatness - Over the last 10 seasons, the Capitals rank first in cumulative points (916), first in power play percentage (22.5 percent), second in total wins (416), second in goals for (2,141) and 11th in goals against (1,817). During that same span, the Capitals rank fourth in playoff wins (53) and fifth in playoff goals (265). Additionally, over the last 10 seasons, the Capitals have won six division titles, including three-straight Metropolitan Division titles, a Prince of Wales Trophy and the Stanley Cup. Including both individual and team trophies, the Capitals have 20 trophies in the last 10 years, tied for the second most in the NHL.

Picking Up Right Where He Left Off - Through the first three games of the season, John Carlson has two goals and four assists, and his six points are tied for second among all defensemen this season. Last season, Carlson recorded 15 goals and 53 assists, all single-season highs, and his 68 points led NHL defensemen. Carlson became the eighth defensemen in franchise history to record 60 points in a season and the first since Mike Green in 2009-10 (76 points, 19g, 57a). Carlson's 68 points were the seventh-highest single season total by a Capital in franchise history. Carlson became the third Capitals defenseman to lead the NHL in points since the year 2000 (Sergei Gonchar: 2001-02, 59 points; Mike Green: 2008-09, 2009-10: 73 and 76 points, respectively). Carlson is one of 25 active defensemen with at least 300 career points (79g, 260a).
